I saw it again yesterday. At different times during the day, two former participants dropped by to say hi and keep in touch. I saw it in their faces, I heard in their voices. I saw hope. I saw Peace. I saw Joy. I thought back to the first time I met each of these individuals. Their individual stories are quite different, but what I saw from each of them looked the same. I saw despair, defeat, hopelessness.

The power of shame is destructive, anxiety and depression can stop us in our tracks, addiction can destroy so many good things in our lives. To be set free from addiction, anxiety, the trauma of past abuse, dependence on anger, and/or low self-esteem we need something big. We

need something powerful that can break the chains of our cycles of defeat.

For a child, Christmas holds a lot of anticipation and excitement. I remember as a child assessing each of the presents that got placed under the tree. The bigger ones drew the most attention from me. I wanted the bigger present.

Now as an adult I realize the bigger gift is exactly what "Advent" is all about. The four markers of Advent are Love, Joy, Peace and Hope. Each of these markers are the core of the Christmas message. Jesus arriving as a baby in the manger, reminds us that God came into our world to be with us and even more than that, to be our savior.

He brought Hope, Peace, Joy, and Love.

What I saw on the faces of those two past participants yesterday was the bigger more powerful gift in action. The hope that we celebrate at Christmas drives out despair. Peace comes when we realize we are not on our own that God is with us and God is for us.

At Rising Above, we are grateful for the opportunity to see hundreds of people break cycles of defeat and experience the power of this bigger gift. The gift of hope, peace, joy and love. It transforms lives. Thank you for your partnership in making this possible.
