Hello everyone, my name is Bill Schmidt and I am a case manager for Rising Above. A lot has happened since our last newsletter, so I am excited to be able to share some updates with you.

Firstly, we have been in our new building and dorm located at 11007 106 St for just over a year now, and we have filled up all the beds, and now house 19 men at the dorm on a regular basis. (Praise God). The facility is great, and we love it, and as you know every new space comes with its own set of growing pains. As with any organization, we have had some people move on and some have joined us as new staff, all of which have many different amazing talents and abilities, making it an exciting time to be working at Rising Above. Our life skills training center has transitioned well, we are now teaching classes on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursdays each week. There is never a dull moment around here, we're always moving and growing.

Secondly as you may know we made a decision to close the Second Chance furniture location in December . We found that as we grew we were not able to sustain that employment initiative with all the new people in the program. We have moved to a job coaching program where our participants volunteer in the city for 10 hours a week. We have found an amazing partner with Mission Thrift store, in the Town Center Mall, who helps us with giving placement for our participants to volunteer. We also teach a job readiness class that helps our participants with resume writing, interviewing questions and confidence. As for the Employment side we are in the process of developing some employer contacts who would be willing to take some of our participants into their workplace and give them a wage earning position and a second chance at employment.

Thirdly, with a lower than normal number of ladies in our program, we have transitioned one of our houses into a Men's House and have 3 of our guys currently living in it. The guys are loving it and say it has given them a new sense of life and freedom.

As always, it's amazing to see what God is doing through this ministry and we are excited to see where He is taking us this year.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank our many sponsors and donors for their continued support over the past year. We acknowledge know that many of you have dug deep, helped and supported us over the years both through the good times and the bad and without you we wouldn't be where we are today. You are important, and you are valued!


