I can honestly say that I would not have had the ability or confidence to start Rising Above if I had not experienced the healing and freedom I gained through Inner Healing. Cory's Story

I've been a heroin addict for 20 years. My addiction started at the age of 12 when I began dabbling with weed and alcohol. By 15 I was doing cocaine and acid. I never once thought I would be a seasoned heroin addict in my 40s.

I grew up in a violent home but never associated my rage with my upbringing. I never understood the pain I was trying to cover up. I just thought I liked doing drugs and couldn't stop. Addiction brought me to very dark places. Jail, the streets, having my children taken from me, having my wife leave me, I even disappeared for over 2 years and my family thought I was dead. I was homeless on the streets of Calgary and, honestly, I didn't want to be found. I did not know how to function properly without drugs and I did not think recovery was possible.

I had the opportunity to come to Rising Above a few years ago, but I thought places like this were institutions, and I had my fill of those places. Why would I voluntarily be "locked up?" Then I was fed a little fib – my mother told me I was going to be a grandfather. This lie saved my life because she knew if I fell for it, it may be my saving grace. It worked! And I am not even mad about it. I needed a wake-up call and a HUGE one. Now I am over 5-months into the program and getting ready to graduate. I never used to cry, ever, but now I cry almost every day. Inner Healing cracked me open and a storehouse of emotions came flooding out – and it hasn't stopped in months! I am just so grateful for this life and for the chance to live it clean. The chance to heal and discover the lies I've carried for a lifetime. Someone told me of a scripture – something about a stone heart and how it becomes like flesh. This resounded with me deeply.

Something I can't quite wrap my head around is why me? Why have I not died? I have witnessed so many deaths by this drug. I was doing the same drug as all of them, and yet here I am. Heroin cooks your brain, but yet I am still functional, and I don't look like I've battled a 20-year heroin addiction. The only answer I have is I must be here for a reason, and I don't want to waste this opportunity.

For anyone reading this who may be struggling, recovery IS possible. It's not easy. But if you're willing to put in the work, it is possible to get clean.
